Reminder PACKET PICK-UP

If you are not on a team, or if you registered on a team with six or fewer runners, you will pick up your 2024 Liz Hurley Ribbon Run race bib and T-shirt this week at the Huntsville Fleet Feet Sports in Jones Valley.

If you are on a team with seven or more runners, your team captain will have your bib and race shirt.

You can also find your bib number by signing into runsignup.com, clicking the person icon in the right corner and clicking "Profile." Scroll down to "Upcoming Events" and find your number under 21st annual Liz Hurley Ribbon Run. We will also have a list of bib numbers at packet pick-up.

Survivor bibs will be available at packet pick-up for all survivors registered for the 5K. Additional survivor bibs for non-5K participants will be available on race day at the Huntsville Hospital Foundation tent in Tent Village, across from Huntsville Junior High School.

Over the course of 21 years, the Liz Hurley Breast Cancer Fund at HHF has raised more than \$7.3 million to provide almost all of the diagnostic equipment that is used to detect breast cancer at Huntsville Hospital Breast Center. This year, proceeds will fund important software upgrades for three 3D mammogram machines that will improve the appearance of mammographic images for more accurate diagnoses..

IMPORTANT RACE INFORMATION

Pre-Race

- 5K runners will receive a race timing B-Tag attached to the back of the race bib. **Please do not remove the B-Tag.** It must be attached as you cross the start and finish lines.
- Your runner number and B-Tag are key to determining your final 5K results. You will not be considered an official participant or scored after you cross the finish line unless you are wearing your runner number with B-Tag. Your runner number must be visible and pinned to the front of your shirt or shorts so it can be seen by race volunteers.
- Verify your name is printed on your race bib, and that all
 information is correct. If not, report to the late packet pickup table by the doors of the Junior High School.
- Please do not cut, tear or fold your race bib.
- Use the pin holes. Please do not pin through the B-Tag on the back of your number.

5K Race

- The 5K will start at 8:30 a.m. following the 8 a.m. Survivors' Walk. Please arrive by 8 a.m.
- Water and refreshments will be available in the finish line area. You must be wearing your race number to receive refreshments.





Timing & Aid Stations

- Timing mats will be placed at the start and finish lines. Results will include both gun start time and mat (B-Tag) start time. Awards will be determined based on gun start time only.
- A water station will be provided along the race route and at the finish line.

Finish Line

- All runners will use the same finish line. Run through the finish line. Please do not stop.
- Remember to look up at the digital clock to see your race time as you approach the finish line!

Notice: For the safety of your child and other participants, we strongly discourage the use of strollers and/or baby joggers. All participants who take the risk of using strollers will be directed to the back of the race lineup. Unregistered runners, unauthorized vehicles, bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, animals and the wearing of headphones are strictly prohibited on the course during the race.

Survivors' Walk

The Survivors' Walk starts at 8 a.m. Survivors, please line up at the SURVIVORS pink flag near the west end zone of the football field, west of the start line on Lowe Avenue.

Race Results & Awards

- Awards will be presented in the tent village near the basketball court.
- Final results will be posted on the front outside wall of Huntsville Junior High School shortly after each 100 runners finish the 5K race.
- The top finisher awards will be given at 10 a.m., or as soon as the results are ready. Age group winners will also be recognized.

Race Day Parking
